

TRANSVAGINAL PELVIC ULTRASOUND

The exam consists in a feminine small pelvis ultrasound evaluation with intracavitary method.

The patient is laid back on her back on the table; the radiologist puts a probe covered with a sterile condom for single use in the vagina and starts the evaluation of uterus and appendages creating an image on the monitor of the pelvic structure without any pain.

If possible, the exam must be done with complete suprapubic pelvic bladder evaluation.

Preparation and warnings

- Full bladder (drink a liter of water one hour before the exam and retain it)
- The exam cannot be done during period
